## **General Entry Guide and Regulations**

1. The Tournament will take place on the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2011, at **Scottish Squash Rackets Club, 10 Malloch Street, Maryhill, Glasgow, G20 8TP.**
2. Eligibility to enter Tournament – anyone who is eligible to represent Scotland under the eligibility rules adopted by Scottish Squash.
3. The monrad system or round robins will be used.
4. The Tournament will be played under the rules of the WSF and the Scottish Squash Code of Conduct and the Fair Play Statement will apply.
5. All matches will be the best of 3 games or timed and the Dunlop Pro XX yellow-dot ball will be used.
6. Scoring used will be point-a-rally (PAR) to 11 as adopted by the European Squash Federation.
7. Players will be required to mark and referee matches.
8. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
9. All competitors in this Tournament, will be listed in order-of-merit. The top 4 entrants go straight into Premier Division 1 while all other entrants are divided into groups of 8 players. A single qualifying round will be played between players in these groups of 8 with the winners taking the remaining 4 places in the Division above and the losing 4 players taking the seeded positions in the Division below. This continues until all players have qualified into monrad draws of 8 players who then complete 3 further rounds of play.
10. Players must compete in all scheduled matches, both main draw and play-off matches.
11. Scheduled match times are a guide only – players are expected to be available to play, immediately after previous matches are complete.
12. Video recording of some matches may take place at this event; photographs may also be taken for promotional purposes including publication on websites. By signing the entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions and parents provide their consent to the taking and use of photos/videos.
13. Drug testing may take place at this event in line with Scottish Squash's Anti Doping Resolution and by signing the entry form players and parents provide their consent for this.
14. Players enter and play in this tournament at their own risk. West Squash & Racketball and Scottish Squash Rackets Club do not accept any responsibility for injury arising from participation in the tournament. Competitors who are not Competitive Player Members of Scottish Squash, or are not covered by Scottish Squash's Personal Accident insurance, are advised to arrange their own Personal Accident insurance cover.
15. Junior players (under 19 on the last day of the event) will be required to wear appropriate eye protection in line with Scottish Squash's Eye Protection Policy.
16. Results will be extracted by age group and player positions will be extracted accordingly - e.g. the best finishing 17 year old may finish 3rd in Division 1, the second finishing 17 year-old may finish 7th in Division 2 - for ranking purposes in their age group, they will be deemed to have finished 1st and 2nd in their age group.
